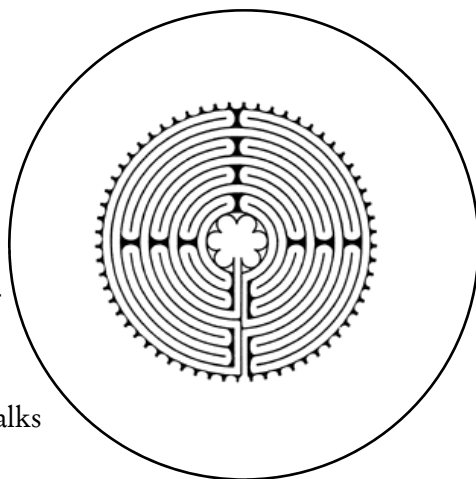

- Offers an oasis in the city that emphasizes service and ministry to city dwellers and downtown workers.



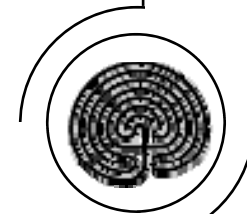

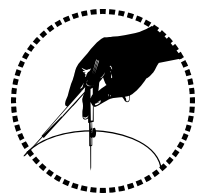

The labyrinth is a tool for meditation and sacred ceremony that has been used by people all over the world. There are many different patterns dating back over 4,000 years.



Labyrinths have appeared in churches since the 12th century, and both ancient and modern designs are in use today. First & Central's labyrinth, open to the public since 1997, is a replica of the labyrinth inlaid in the floor of Chartres Cathedral in France.

The mission of the First & Central Labyrinth Project is to make the labyrinth available to all who are interested in walking and learning from it. Our goals are to provide a place for reflection and peace and to nurture a Labyrinth Community willing to share our thoughts, learning and experiences of walking the labyrinth with one another and with other labyrinth walkers worldwide.

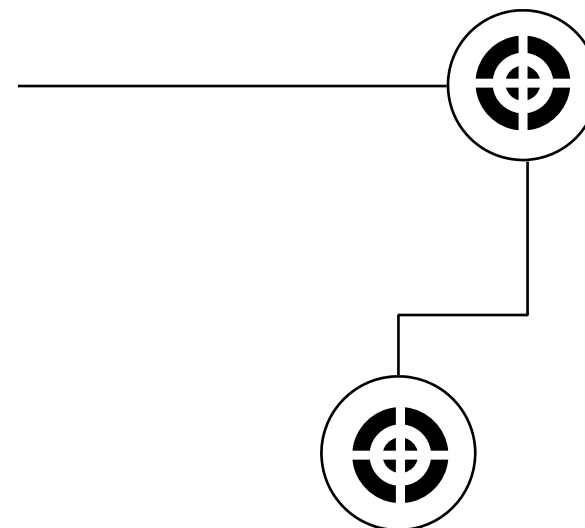
